

The Allred Brothers are the three most successful siblings in the sport of racing the fastest horses on earth. Choosing to live and breed their horses in Arizona, Harvey, Dale and Jerry have spent their lives working for the betterment of quarter horse racing in Arizona and were ranked nationally in the top ten breeders, for many years. They raised so many champions, and were original members of the Dash for cash and Streakin Six Syndicates: They also had shares in Rocket Wrangler, Cassidy Casanova and The Signature. They raised one little Arizona Bred horse called Mark T Bars who still holds the world record for the most races won by a quarter horse. He ran till he was twelve and retired sound after winning 64 races (most stakes races) at our Arizona tracks.

Harvey passed away in 2000, after a lengthy fight with cancer, Dale passed away in 2001 after a courageous battle with Parkinson disease. Jerry ran the farm (breeding and Racing) until 2012 when he too passed away. The family has since sold the Allred farm to developers. But their legend and memory will live on. Harvey's Son John and daughter in law Mary Allred are carrying on the legacy with breeding and racing.
